and sold and by these Presents do and each of doth grant bargain
and sell unto him the said Philip They his executors administrators
and assigns all that tract or parcel of land called Mollaway lying and

acres also all that tract or parcel of Land called St. Catherine's Island
lying and being in Saint Mary's County aforesaid containing one
