 said Samson Levy demand Six hundred thousand pounds of Inspected Tobaccos on
 Patuxent River to weight nine hundred and thirty six pounds Seal at an average
 including the fees of Court for Cash in consideration of which the said Samson
 Levy obliges himself to Pay said George Maxwell Seven hundred Pounds Sterling
 the first Day of November next and then to remit to Mr. Isaac Levy of London Merch^t
 Seven hundred Pounds Sterling more to be in Part of a cargo of Goods of ten thousand
 Pounds Sterling which the said Samson Levy is to order the said Isaac Levy to ship in
 the Spring is Patuxent on Acc^t of the said George Maxwell agreeable to an Invoice to be
 sent home by the said George Maxwell and Promises that the said Isaac Levy shall
 comply therewith and the said George Maxwell obliges himself to Pay seven hundred
 Pounds Sterling further towards the Payment of the said Good on the last Day of
 August one thousand seven hundred and fifty and, or deliver Samson Levy one
 hundred Hhd^s Tobaccos within a month after the receipt of the Goods as the said
 (Samson)
