 said Amelia Chapman the Receipt whereof the said  
 William Lock Weems doth hereby acknowledge and  
 thereof and of every part thereof doth Acquit release  
 and Discharge the said Nathaniel Chapman his heirs  
 Executors and Administrators by these Presents and for  
 Providing a competent Furniture and livelihood for the  
 said Amelia Chapman in case she shall after the  
 intended Marriage happen to survive the said William  
 Lock Weems her intended husband and for setting the  
 Lands and Slaves herein after mentioned upon the Trusts  
 and to and for the uses Intents and Purposes with and
