




 for Granting a Supply of forty thousand Pounds for his Majesty Service -
 and striking thirty four thousand and fifteen Pounds six Shillings thereof
 in Bills of Credit and Raising a Fund for Sinking the same and do well and
 and faithfully pay to the Commissioners of the Loan office for the time
 being the several Sums of Money which he shall Receive and be answerable
 for in Virtue of the same Act at such times as by the said Act is Direct
 according to the true Intent and meaning thereof then the above -
 Obligation to be void and of no Effect otherwise to remain in full force
 and virtue
