Containing one thousand Acres Litteronna granted for
Four hundred Acres. But containing within the Borders
thereof One thousand One hundred and Seventy Acres And
Whereas the Parties to these Presents have come to an
agreement to Divide and Exchange the said Lands in the
following Manner Viz: That Charles Carroll Esq. shall have
the whole Tract of Land called Doohoregan Containing ten
thousand Acres and the whole Tract of Land called France
Containing Nine hundred and Sixty nine Acres and that
Charles Carroll Junior shall have the whole Tract of Land —
