Seventeen hundred and sixty three Between John Hespelius of Ann Arundel  
County Sumner of the one part, and Horatio Sharpe of the City of Annapolis  
Esquire of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Hespelius for and in  
Consideration of the Sum of Five Shillings Sterling Money of Great Britain to him in  
hand paid by the said Horatio Sharpe at or before the sealing and delivery of these  
presents the receipt whereof the said John Hespelius Doth hereby acknowledge and  
that of and there from and of every part and parcel thereof doth hereby acquit release  
concoate and discharge the said Horatio Sharpe his Executors Administrators  
and assigns and every of them All Bargained and Sold and by these presents  
Doth Bargain and Sell unto the said Horatio Sharpe All that part or  
parcel
