Merchant of the other part Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the Sum
of Five Shillings of Lawfull Money of Great Britain to the Said James Wardrop in hand paid
by the Said John Buchanan at or before the Sealing and Delivery of these Presents the
Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the Said James Wardrop At the Said James Wardrop
Hath Bargained and Sold and by these presents Doth bargain and Sell unto the Said
John Buchanan All that one full and Equal undivided fourth part or Share of him the
Said James Wardrop (the whole into four equal parts or Shares to be divided) of and in all
those several Tracts or parcels of Land Hereditaments and Promises Situate lying and
being in Baltimore County in the Said Province of Maryland formerly purchased by
Alexander Lawson of the Said Province of Maryland Merch^t. James Russell now of
