This Indenture made the fourteenth day of November in the year
of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty three, Between Edward Digg^r
William Digg^r Junior & Henry Digg^r in the Province of Maryland Gentlemen
of the one part and Christian Howar of Lancaster County in the Province of
Pennsylvania of the other part witnesseth that the said Edward, William and
Henry Digg^r for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred & fifty pounds
to them in hand paid by the said Christian Howar before the sealing and
Delivery of these presents wherewith the said Edward, William & Henry Digg^r, do
acknowledge themselves to be fully Contented Have given granted Bargained
Sold and Conformed and by these presents do give grant Bargain Sell and Confirm
unto the said Christian Howar all that parcel of Land being part of a Tract
of Land called Digg^rs Choice and beginning at a post by Thomas Adams
Fence and running thence North Twenty Degrees West Seventy four Perches North
Sixty one degrees East three hundred & forty five perches, South Twenty Degrees
East Seventy four Perches then by a direct Line to the beginning Containing
One hundred and fifty acres of Land with the Rights Members and Appurtenances
thereof and also all the Right Title Claim or Demand of the said Edward,
William & Henry Digg^r of in and to all and singular the premises above
mentioned with the appurtenances To have and to Hold the aforesaid One
hundred and Fifty acres of Land with the appurtenances unto the said
