 presents Doth give grant bargain sell alien release convey and confirm
 unto him the said Laurelet Jacques his heirs and assigns One undivided moiety
 of all and each and every of those three Tracts or parcels of Land Granted to him
 the said Thomas Johnson Junior lying and being in Frederick County
