 ing in Pathmosse County being Part of a Tract of Land called Elys Lott  
 Beginning for the said Tract or Parcell of Land at the end of the eight course  
 of the said Tract and running thence and Bounding on the Original Survey  
 the Eleven following Courses South Seventy nine degrees east sixteen Poles South  
 eighty eight degrees east forty six Poles South thirty five degrees east eighteen  
 Poles South Twenty degrees West Thirty Poles South thirty two degrees  
 east Twenty six Poles North forty five degrees east thirty four Poles North  
 thirty six Poles North seventy eight degrees east Twenty two Poles North  
 eighteen degrees West thirty six Poles North forty two degrees West forty  
 eight Poles North fifty three degrees West thirty four Poles and then  
 with a straight line to the Beginning containing and now laid out for  
 fifty Acres of Land More or Less according to the said Land and all the  
 Impediments thereunto belonging unto my said son Edward Dorsey his Heirs
