

On the 19th March 1764 came Mr. Edward Dorsey Jun^r before us two of Lordships Justices of the Peace for Ann Arundell County and Acknowledged the within Deed and the Lands therein mentioned to be the Right and Estate of the within named Edw^d Dorsey Jun^r his Heirs and Assigns forever and According to the Act of Assembly in that Case made Provided and the same day came Sarah Dorsey the Wife of the above said Edward Dorsey and being Privately examined according to the Law Acknowledged her Right of Dower in the within mentioned Land to be Right and Estate of the within named Edw^d Dorsey Jun^r his Heirs and Assigns forever without any fears or threats from her Husband
