This Indenture made this first day of March in the Year of our Lord seven  
 hundred and Sixty four Between William Wray of Queen Anne County Plan-  
 ter of the one Part and John Gordon of Talbot County Clerk of the other Part Witness-  
 eth that the said William Wray for and in Consideration of the sum of five  
 shillings Sterling Money to him in Hand Paid by the aforesaid John Gordon  
 at or before the enrolling and Delivery of these Presents the receipt whereof is  
 hereby Acknowledged Hath Granted Bargained and Sold And by these  
 Presents Doth grant Bargain and Sell unto him the said John Gordon  
 his Executors Administrators and Assigns All those Parts of four Tracts of  
 Land lying and being in Talbot County aforesaid on the North West side  
 of Michaels River near the Place of Forging over the said River known  
 by the names of Daniels Rest Walkers South Partnership and Walkers  
 Corner Beginning at a least Post set down in the Place where a bounded  
 Gum formerly stood which said Gum was a Divisional Boundary Between  
 William and Charles Walker and running from the said Post North forty  
 degrees thirty Minutes West three hundred and ten Poles to the exterior  
 Bounds of the aforesaid Land called Partnership thence with that Land  
 North forty six degrees and thirty Minutes East one hundred and twenty  
 four Poles then South sixteen degrees West twelve Poles then South  
 East one hundred and fifteen Poles then South by East one hundred ~~and~~  
~~and~~ and thirty two Poles then East by North twenty five Poles then  
 South east three Poles to a Tract of Land called Walkers Corner thence with  
 that Land South fifty five degrees and thirty Minutes West fifty two Poles then  
 South twenty six degrees east fourteen Poles then South east fifty Poles  
 to Saint Michaels River then down the same the several courses thereof  
 to the Mouth of a Cove then bounding with the said Cove up to the  
 (aforesaid)
