This Indenture made this ^{first} day of February in the Year of our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and Sixty four Between John Bell Jun^r of Parms Georges County in the Province of Maryland Planter of the one Part and Estroo Bell of the same County and Province Planter of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Bell Jun^r for and in Consideration of the sum of five shillings Sterling Money to him in Hand Paid by the said Estroo Bell the receipt whereof the said John Bell Jun^r doth hereby Acknowledge and therefrom Acquit and discharge the said Estroo Bell his Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns Both released ^{and} Surrendered Yielded up and by these Presents Doth Release Surrender and Yield up to him the said Estroo Bell his Heirs and Assigns all those ^{undivided} two hundred and fifty Acres of Land of that Part of a Tract of Land called the Inclusion containing fifteen hundred and three Acres of Land lying in Parms Georges County aforesaid the said last mentioned Part being to be Divided into three ~~equal~~ parts of two hundred and fifty Acres each and one part of ^{two} hundred and ninety Acres and the whole of the said Part so to be Divided as aforesaid is better and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at the South east Corner of a Powell's Land (formerly)

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
