Merrill of Worcester County in the Province of Maryland of the first Part
and Sampson Merrill of the same Place of the second Part and Thomas Merrill
of the same Place of the ^{third} Part Witnesseth that the said William Merrill
for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five Pounds current Money
of Maryland to him in Hand Paid by the said Thomas Merrill and
before the sealing and Delivery hereof the receipt whereof the said William
hereby doth Acknowledge and for the better further and better Enjoying of
the Lands and Tenements with his ~~Heirs and Assigns~~ the Appurtenances
herein afterwards Particularly Described and mentioned to the said Thomas
Merrill his Heirs and Assigns forever hath Granted Bargained and sold
and doth hereby Grant Bargain and Sell unto the said Thomas Merrill
his Heirs and Assigns forever One hundred Acres of Land with the Appur-
tenances in Worcester County aforesaid being Part of a Tract of Land called
Orruoco and is that One hundred Acres of Land which William
Merrill late of the County aforesaid deced. Grandfather of the said William
Merrill by his last Will and Testament in Writing bearing Date the
Twenty third Day of January Anno Domini seventeen hundred and
Nine and ten did Devise unto his son William Merrill Father of
the said William Merrill Party to these Presents in fee Tail under the
