 of the other Part Witnesseth That the said Valentine Shugren for and in Considera-
 tion of the sum of One hundred Pounds Current Money to him in Hand Paid by the
 said Conrad Meckell at or before the sealing and Delivery of these Presents the Re-
 ceipt whereof he doth hereby Acknowledge and thereof and there forward of and from
 every Part and Parcel thereof doth hereby ^{release} Acquit and Discharge the said
 Conrad Meckell his Heirs Executors and Administrators Heath Given Granted
 bargained sold Aliened released enfeoffed and Confirmed And by these Presents
 Doth give Grant bargain sell Alien release enfeoff and Confirms unto him
 the said Conrad Meckell his Heirs and Assigns All that Tract or Parcel
 of Land situate lying and being in Frederick County called Sweet Molly Be-
 -ing Part of a Rowway made on a Tract of Land called Choue lying in the
 County aforesaid Beginning at the end of the thirty sixth Part in the Ninth
 Line of the aforesaid Survey running thence South Twenty four Degrees
 (and)
