This Indenture made the fifteenth day of May in the Year of our Lord One
 Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty four Between Henry Hall of Ann
 Arundel County in the Province of Maryland Gentlemen of the one Part
 and John Hall of the County and Province aforesaid Attorney at Law of the
 other Part Whereas William Demme of Prince Georges County died by Deed
 bearing Date on or about the seventh day of December in the Year of our
 Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Sixty three for the consideration
 therein mentioned gave Grant Bargain and sell unto him the same
 Henry Hall his Heirs and Assigns forever all that Tract Piece or Parcel
 of Land or Part of a Tract Piece or Parcel of Land lying situate and being
 in Prince Georges County and now known by the Name of Demmes Tract
 -thats it being Part of that Part of Tract or Parcel of Land heretofore sold by
 Henry Hall of Ann Arundel County (tho unto Jacob Henderson and Robert
 Taylor both of Prince Georges County aforesaid) and then estimated and called Part
 of Parrets Manor) Beginning for said Land at a bounded Wherry standing
 on the West side of Patuxent River and running from thence West three
 hundred and Twenty Perches then North North West ninety eight Perches
 then east three hundred and twenty Perches then North sixteen Perches
 then East forty Perches to Patuxent River then bounding by and with
 the said River to the first Beginning here containing and laid out for
 Two hundred Acres of Land more or less together with all Woods Under
 Woods Timber and Timber Trees Houses Orchards Gardens Fences and
 Appurtenances to the same belonging To hold the said Land and Premises
 to him the said Henry Hall his Heirs and Assigns forever as by the same
 Deed duly acknowledged and Recorded in Prince Georges County Clarks
