 Grant Bargain sell Alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said John Price
 his Heirs and Assigns forever all those several Tracts Parts Parcels and Lots of
 Land mentioned in the aforesaid Deed of Mortgage lying and being in
 Baltimore County aforesaid that is to say all that Tract or Parcels of Land lying and
 being in Baltimore County aforesaid on the Little falls of Gum Powder River granted
 to a certain Stephen Union deceased on or about the seventeenth day of August
 Seventeen hundred and forty two Pursuant and in virtue of an Act of Assembly
 for the encouragement of an Iron Manufacture within this Province Beginning
