



and doth bear unto the said Lurania Toneyhill and for and in Consideration of the sum of Five Pounds Sterling to her in Hand Paid by the said Lurania Toneyhill the Receipt whereof the said Capandrea Smith doth hereby Acknowledge and Confess and for other Good Causes And the said Capandrea Smith hath Given Granted Bargained and Sold and by these Presents doth Give Grant Bargain and Sell unto her the said Lurania Toneyhill Two Negro Children One named Cristo the other named George, with one new Iron eight Gallon Pott, two Iron Basons, One Grid Iron and one Ladle and Spill and a large Iron Trap To have and to hold the said two Negro Children named Cristo and George and all and singular the ^{other} Goods and Chattells unto the said Lurania Toneyhill her Heirs Executors & Administrators and Assigns and the said Capandrea Smith for herself, her Executors, Administrators and Assigns doth hereby Covenant Grant and Agree to and with the said Lurania Toneyhill her Executors Administrators and Assigns that she the said Capandrea Smith the two Negro Children and all other the Goods and Chattells above mentioned to the said Lurania Toneyhill her Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns shall and will Warrant and for ever defend the said two Negro Children and all the Goods and Chattells above mentioned from all Manner of Persons whatever by these Presents, in Witness whereof the said Capandrea Smith doth Affix her Hand and Seal
