This Indenture made this Twenty eighth day of July one thousand seven hundred Sixty and four Between Alexander Weall Robert Weall and Archibald Samonston of Frederick County in the Province of Maryland of the one Part and James Weall (Son of James) of the County aforesaid of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Alexander Weall Robert Weall and Archibald Samonston for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred Pounds current Money of Maryland by the name James Weall to the said Alex<sup>r</sup> Weall Robert Weall and Archib<sup>l</sup> Samonston before the Execution of these Presents in Hand Paid the Receipt whereof the said Alex<sup>r</sup> Weall Robert Weall & Archibald Samonston Doth Acknowledge Both Granted Bargained Sold Alien<sup>d</sup> <sup>released</sup> enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these Presents Doth Grant Bargain Sell Alien<sup>d</sup> release enfeoff and Confirms unto the name James Weall all that two Tracts or Parcels of Land called Josephs Disappointment being Part of a Tract of Land called the Resurvey on Bratchellors Forrest Origin<sup>l</sup> Granted to James Samonston Robert Weall & Alex<sup>r</sup> Weall lying and being in Frederick County Beginning for the Part hereby Granted Parcel of Land at the end of the ~~Fourth~~ forty fifth line of a Tract of Land which is South fifteen degrees West eighty four Perches then running with a
