on the other Part Witnesseth that the said William Woodward & Mary Holmes

hereby Acknowledged have Granted Bargained & sold & by these Presents do
Grant Bargain and sell unto the aforesaid Benjamin Tashor Charles Carroll

Carroll the Younger all those two Tracts or Parcels of Land situate lying
and being with the Appurtenances in Baltimore County called or known
