This Indenture made this eleventh day of February in the Year of our Lord
in the Year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and Sixty four Between
William Woodward of the City of Annapolis Gentlemen in his own Right and
Mary Holmes of Newington Parke in the County of Essex in the Kingdom
of England Witness by the said William Woodward his Attorney for that Purpose
lawfully constituted and Appointed on the one Part and Benjamin Tashel
Charles Carroll Charles Carroll Barrister at Law Daniel Dulany & Walter
Dulany of the City of Annapolis Squires & Charles Carroll the Younger
of Prince Georges County Squire on the other Part Whereas Amos Garrett
late of the City of Annapolis Merchant Deceased was in his lifetime and at
the Time of his Decease seized of and intitled unto sundry Tracts or Parcels
of Land in the Province of Maryland and that Mary Woodward & Elizabeth
Gin late of the City of London in the Kingdom of Great Brittain England
Widows were the Surviving Sisters and Heirs at Law of Amos Garrett by
reason whereof the said Tracts or Parcels descended unto and Devolved upon
the said Mary Woodward & Elizabeth Gin upon the Death of the said
Amos Garrett in undivided Meeties and among others the said Tracts
or Parcels of Land were the Tracts or Parcels of Land following (that is
to say) the Land of Goshen and Commons Delight Situate lying and
(being)
