This Indenture made the fourth day of September in the Year of our
 Lord Christ Seventeen hundred and Sixty four Between the Vestrymen and
 Church Wardens of the Parish of St. Margaret Westminster in Ann Arundel
 County in Maryland of the first Part William West Rector and Minister
 of the same Parish of the second Part and Horatio Sharpe of the County
 aforesaid Heir of the third Part Whereas Charles Greenbury of Ann Arun-
 del County Heir in or about the Year Seventeen hundred and ten died ^{or Parcell} ~~was~~
 and possessed of an Estate of Free Simple of and in all that Tract of Land Origin-
 -ally called Tuller and now commonly known by the name of Whitehall
 Situate lying and being in Ann Arundel County aforesaid on the West side
 of Chesapeake Bay and on the North side of a River in the said Bay called
 Severn River and on the North side of a Creek called Homewoods Creek
 And the said Charles Greenbury by his last Will and Testament duly Pro-
 -ved and Registered devised the same Tract or Parcell of Land (by the name
 and Description of all that his Plantation called Whitehall and the Land
 thereto belonging unto the Vestry of the Parish aforesaid (by the name
 of the Vestry of Westminster Parish) for the better Support and
 Maintenance
