 Henry Greenfield Sothoron and his Heirs Executors & Administrators in case the said  
 Tract of Land called the Grange shall at any Time here after be legally taken from the  
 said Richard Henderson his heirs or assigns or that he the said Richard Henderson  
 his Heirs or assigns shall be legally evicted or dispossessed thereof that then the  
 said Henry Greenfield Sothoron his heirs Executors or Administrators shall repay to the  
 said Richard Henderson his Heirs or assigns the aforesaid Three hundred & fifty pounds  
 Sterling Money of Great Britain immediately when Demanded after such Eviction  
 or Dispossession aforesaid and upon the repayment of the said Three hundred & fifty  
 Pounds Sterling by the said Henry Greenfield Sothoron his heirs Executors or Administrators  
 to the said Richard Henderson his Heirs or assigns when Demanded by the said  
 Richard Henderson his Heirs or assigns after such Eviction or Dispossession as  
 aforesaid then the said Richard Henderson his Heirs or assigns shall Reconvey unto  
 the said Henry Greenfield Sothoron and his heirs all the Right of Title of him the  
 said Richard Henderson his Heirs or assigns to the aforesaid Tract of Land called the  
 Grange with the Premises & Appurtenances In Witness whereof the said  
 Henry Greenfield Sothoron hath set his hand and affixed his seal to these
