 expectant or Depending of and in the Lands and Appurtenances hereinaf-
 ter mentioned the said John Hall as Demandant is hereafter (at the ^{request} Costs and
 Charges of the said Samuel Gorn and James Gorn to Prosecute and sue out of his
 Lordships high Court of Chancery his said Lordships Writ of entry surdisseisin en-
 lepost against them the same Samuel Gorn and Joseph Gorn returnable and to
 be returned to the next Provincial Court at Annapolis on the second Tuesday
 of September next whereby the said John Hall is to Demand against them
