On the seventh day of November 1761 Came before me the Subscriber one of his
Majesties Provincial Justices Mary the Wife of the said William Pinkston and
being by me Privately examined apart and out of the hearing of her said Hus-
band did release and declare that She did by this ^{her} Acknowledgement intend to
release all her Right and Title of Power of in and to the within Land and
Premises within mentioned to the within named Thomas Johnson Junior his Heirs
and Assigns forever and did also declare and Acknowledge that She made such her
release and Acknowledgment Voluntarily and freely without being induced
thereto by fears or Threats of or ill Usage from her said Husband or through
fear of his Displeasure According to the Act of Assembly in such Case made
and Provided

This Indenture made this sixth day of October in the Year of our Lord
God One thousand seven hundred and sixty four Between Caspandra Smith
of Calvert County in the Province of Maryland Widow of the one Part and Cas-
pandra Smythill of the County and Province aforesaid Grand Daughter of the said
Caspandra Smith of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Caspandra Smith
as well for and in Consideration of the Natural Love and Affection which
She the said Caspandra Smith hath and beareth unto the said Caspandra Smythill
as also for the better Maintenance Livelihood and Preferment of her the said
Caspandra Smythill hath given Granted Aliened enfeoffed and Confirmed and
by these Presents doth Give Grant Alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Cas-
pandra Smythill her Heirs and Assigns one Negro Child named Dyson
To have and to hold the said Negro aforesaid unto the said Caspandra
Smythill her Heirs and Assigns to the only Proper Use and behoof of her
the said Caspandra Smythill her Heirs and Assigns forever And the said Cas-
pandra Smith for herself her Heirs Executors and Administrators Doth Covenant
and Grant to and with the said Caspandra Smythill her Heirs and Assigns
by these Presents that She the said Caspandra Smythill her Heirs and
Lawfully may from hence forth forever hereafter Peaceably and Quietly have
holy Possess and enjoy the said Negro aforesaid hereby Granted free clear
and Discharged or well and Sufficiently saved and kept harmless of and
from all former and other Grants bargains Sales Gifts entails and from all others
