This Indenture made this Seventeenth day of January Seventeen hundred and Sixty five Between Lancelot Jacques and Thomas Johnson Senior of Annapolis of the one Part and John Rogers of the same Place Attorney at law of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Lancelot Jacques & Thomas Johnson Sen^r for and in consideration of the sum of ten shillings Current Money to them in hand Paid by the said John Rogers the receipt whereof they do hereby Acknowledge have Granted Bargained and Sold And by these Presents doth Grant Bargain and Sell unto him the said John Rogers his Heirs and Assigns forever all that Part of a Tract or Parcel of Land called Kindreds lying and being in Frederick County which is included within the following Lines to wit Beginning at the end of the North fourteen degrees east fifty six Perches line of the said whole Tract and running thence with the Lines thereof North Seventy degrees east Eighty Perches South thirteen degrees east one hundred and twenty Perches and from thence to the Beginning of the said Part containing twenty Acres of Land more or less together with the Appurtenances thereto belonging To have and to hold the said part of the Tract of Land aforesaid and Appurtenances to him the said John Rogers his Heirs and Assigns to the only proper use and behoof In Witness whereof the Parties to these Presents have hereunto interchangeably set their Hands and Affixed their Seals the day and Year first above Written
