

January Twenty first Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and forty ye I therefore Certify as Deputy Surveyor of Prince Georges County under his Excellency Samuel Ogle Esq^r Governor of Maryland I have Carefully laid out for and in the Name of him the Said Michael Taylor all that Tract of Land lying in the Said County called Called Taylors Burgh beginning at a Bounded White Oak standing on the North side of the Eastern Branch of Patowmack River about Sixty five perches below the Fork of the Said Branch the Said Tree being also the beginning Tree of a parcel of Land called Chance formerly surveyed for Mr Joseph Ches and running thence North twelve Degrees East Twenty Perches, then North six Degrees East forty perches, then South sixty three and a half degree East Twenty Eight perches, then South Fifty Eight perches then West South West Fourteen Perches, then South Forty degree East fifty perches, then South to East one hundred and Fifteen perches then West South West Twenty seven perches, then by a straight line to the Beginning Tree containing and now laid out for thirty eight acres of Land to be held by Calverton Manner surveyed this Fifteenth day of July Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and Forty one Peter Deard deputy Surveyor of Prince Georges County
