and at his pleasure to revoke Ratifying and by these Presents allowing and holding for firm
Effectual and Valid all and whatsoever my said Attorney shall in my Name lawfully do or
Cause to be done in and about the Premises by virtue of these presents In witness whereof I the
said Berce Higgons have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this Twenty fourth day of January in the year of
