This Indenture made this 22nd day of February One thousand seven hundred sixty five Between Nicholas Worthington of Ann Arundel County of the one part and Thomas Worthington of Baltimore County of the other part witnesseth that the said Nicholas Worthington for and in Consideration of the sum of sixty pounds sterling Money of England to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Worthington at or before the Concluding and delivery of these presents the Receipt of which the said Nicholas does hereby acknowledge and thereof and therefrom & of & from every part and parcel thereof Doth freely fully & absolutely Exonerate acquit and for ever discharge the said Thomas Worthington his heirs Executors adm^{rs} & every of them by these Presents hath given granted bargained sold aliened Enfeofed Premised Released & Confirmed and by these Presents Doth give grant bargain sell alien Enfeof Premise Release and Confirm unto him the said Thomas Worthington his heirs and Assigns for ever all them two Tracts of Land lying in Baltimore County called Betticoats Benefit & Betticoats addition containing by his Lordships Warrants three hundred and thirty acres more or less, with all and singular the appurtenances to the said Land belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the said two Tracts of Land with the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said Thomas Worthington his heirs and Assigns for ever and to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Thomas Worthington his heirs and Assigns for ever and to none other use Intent or Purpose whatsoever and the said Nicholas Worthington for himself his heirs Ex^{ca} adm^{rs} and every of them Doth Covenant promise grant and agree to and with the said Thomas Worthington his heirs and Assigns that he the said Nicholas Worthington and his heirs shall and will from time to time and at all times hereafter Warrant and forever defend unto the said Thomas Worthington his heirs and Assigns all the abovementioned bargained Land and premises with its appurtenances against him the said Nicholas Worthington & his heirs or all persons Claiming from by or under him but no further In witness whereof the Parties to these presents have hereunto set their Hands and Seals the day and year above written, Nicholas Worthington *(seal)* signed sealed & delivered in the presence of, the words (Land and) being first interlined, Sarah Price, John Price.
