This Indenture made the Eighteenth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and sixty five between Edward Bell son and heir at Law to William Bell late of Baltimore County in the Province of Maryland Deceased of the one part and John Beale Bordley of the same County and Province Gentleman of the other part, witnesseth that the said Edward Bell for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty pounds Sterling Money to him in Hand by the said John Beale Bordley paid the receipt whereof the said Richard Bell doth hereby acknowledge and himself to be therewith fully satisfied contented and paid; hath granted bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed Released and Confirmed, and by these Presents Doth grant Bargain sell alien Enfeoffe Release and Confirm unto the said John Beale Bordley his Heirs and assigns for ever all that Lot peace or parcel of Land situate on the North West Branch of Patapsco River near Baltimore Town in the County aforesaid being part of a tract or parcel of Land called Tolls Prospect (and sometimes called Tolls point) and being that part of said Tract of Land which was lately laid off and divided by the said Edward Bell into three Lots Numbered 61, 62 and 63, Beginning at a Stone in the Ground marked EB 61, at the Corner of the Streets or Spaces left for highways, called Tolls street and Bonds street; and running from the said Stone South thirty Degrees East bounding on the said Bonds street to the aforesaid North West Branch of Patapsco River. Then again beginning at the said Stone and Corner and running from thence bounding on Tolls street aforesaid North Sixty Degrees East one hundred and Eighty feet, from thence running South Thirty Degrees East to the aforesaid North West Branch of Patapsco River.
