That he the said Edward Bell and his heirs shall and will forever hereafter leave and keep open and unobstructed all the Streets Lanes and Ways by him heretofore laid out and intended for Common use on the aforesaid tract of Land and place, laid out by him the said Edward Bell for a Town on and about the said Hells Point for the Benefit and use of the said John Beale Bordley his Heirs and Assigns and as Common & Publick Streets Lanes and Ways for the passage of all manner of Persons Carriages and things whatsoever.
