made and provided And at the same time came Mary the Wife of
the said Henry who being examined apart from and out of the
hearing of her said Husband relinquished all her right and Title
of Dower of in and to the Lands & Premises aforesaid and declared
that she made the same relinquishment willingly and freely with-
out being compelled thereto by threats from or fear of ill usage
from her said Husband or this fear of his displeasure
