This Indenture made this fifth day of April in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred and sixty five Between William Gaither of An Arundel County Gentleman of the one Part and John Hammond and Denton Hammond each of the County aforesaid Gent: of the other Part Whereas the s: John Hammond and Denton Hammond did on or about the third Day of July last past at the Special Instance and Request of the above named William Gaither bind themselves jointly and severally with and become securities for him the s: William in an injunction Bond given by him for the Purposes therementioned and under the Penalty and Condition in said Bond specified and beforeforesaid Reference unto the same filed in the Chancery Court being had may appear And Whereas the Writ of Injunction thereon obtained and sued out by s: William is at length (according to Information) dissolved and that the his Sureties by name as aforesaid and each of them are liable and likely to satisfy and pay as well the Debt and Costs recovered at Law against the said William as also the Damages and Charges that the Court of Chancery may or shall award against him for Delay of Execution on the Judgment at Law against him by his Process of Injunction aforesaid And forasmuch as the security heretofore made by said William unto s: John Hammond and a certain Philip Hammond by Indenture bearing Date the sixth Day of December Anno Dom: one thousand seven hundred and sixty two, and recorded in An Arundel County Land Records in Lib: B.B.
