This Indenture made this eighth Day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty five Between Leonard Greenwell of Saint Marys County Planter and Winifred his wife of the first Part John Booth of the same County planter of the second Part and James Tilghman the third of the City of Annapolis attorney at Law of the third Part Witnesseth that for the doeing bearing and extinguishing of all Estates Tail of and in the Lands Tenements and other the Hereditaments therein after mentioned their and every of their Appurtenances and all Reversions and Remainders Residues expectant or depending and for settling the same Lands Tenements and Hereditaments with their and every of their appurtenances to for and upon the uses Intents and Purposes herein after mentioned and declared particularly and for and in Consideration of the sum of three thousand pounds of Good Tobacco to the said Leonard Greenwell and Winifred his wife in hand paid by the said John Booth at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for other Good Causes and Considerations hereunto moving they the said Leonard Greenwell and Winifred his wife (by and with the advice and Consent of the said James Tilghman Testified by his being party to and his sealing and executing these presents have granted bargained sold aliened remised released enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien remise released enfeoff and confirm unto the said John Booth (in his actual Possession now being by Virtue of a Bargain and Sell to him thereof made by the said Leonard Greenwell and Winifred his wife by Indenture bearing Date the Day next before the Day of the Date of these presents
