 for and in Consideration of the Sum of Forty Six Pounds Current Money to him in hand
 paid by the said William Swartz, at or before the Executing and Delivery of these Presents, the
 Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Make granted bargained and sold, & by these presents
 Doth Bargain and sell unto the said William Swartz and his Heirs all that part of a
 Tract of Land called Edwards Discovery lying and being partly in Ann Arundel County
 and partly in Baltimore County which said part hereby Intended to be sold, shall be
 limited by the following Metes and Bounds Viz Beginning at the End of the North twenty three
 degrees East Eighty perches line of the whole Tract, and running thence towards on the said Land
 the four following Courses Viz South Twenty three degrees West Eighty perches, South Sixty one
 degrees East fifty two perches North Seventy degrees East Seventy two perches, North
 five Degrees East Ninety Two Perches to the falls, then North Eighty two degrees & thirty Minutes
 West Ten perches, North five degrees East Sixteen perches, North Eighty two Degrees and
 thirty Minutes West Twenty Seven perches; South two degrees East Eight perches -
 so a Branch; then with a straight line to the place of Beginning containing and laid
 out for Sixty five Acres more or less, with all and singular the appurtenances -
