-able the Lord Proprietary's Provincial magistrates for the Province of Mary-
-land and acknowledged the within Deed to be their Act and the Lands
and Premises with the Appurtenances therein mentioned to be the Right
and Estate of the said Benjamin Prather his Heirs and Assigns for ever
and likewise did severally acknowledge the within Instrument of Writing
to be their respective Acts and Deed to and for the Uses Intents and Purposes
therein mentioned. And the said Lucy Wife to the said Benjamin Prather and
being by me examined privately out of the Hearing of her Husband declared
that she made the above Acknowledgment willingly and freely and without
being induced thereto by Force or Threats of ill Usage by her Husband or
Fear of his Displeasure. Taken and certified according to Act of Assembly by
me this first Day of August in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred and sixty
