This Indenture made this Eight<sup>th</sup> Day October in the year  
of our Lord Seventeen Hundred and sixty five between John Row of  
Frederick County in the Province of Maryland Gentleman of the  
one part and David Rops of Prince Georges County and Province  
aforesaid Surgeon of the other part Witnesseth that for and in  
consideration of the sum of Five Shillings current Money to  
him the said John Row in hand paid by the said David Rops  
the Receipt Whereof is hereby acknowledged and also to secure the  
payment to the said David Rops his Executors Administrators  
or Assigns of the sum of Ninety Pounds Sterling Money of Great  
Britain with Interest thereon due from the said John Row to  
Daniel Dillany of the City of Annapolis and which sum the said  
David Rops became security to the said Dillany in a Joint Bond  
with the said John Row and also for the payment of twenty  
four pounds four Shillings eleven pence current Money due  
and owing by the said John Row to the said David Rops And  
also in consideration that the said David Rops hath  
become security for the payment of a Debt of one hundred  
thirteen pounds six Shillings and nine pence current Money  
due
