## CHAPTER 573

## (House Bill 942)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 569 through 580 of Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition, 1965 Replacement Volume), title "Health," subtitle "Milk and Milk Products," and to enact Sections 569 to 586 to said Article 43, title "Health," subtitle "Milk and Milk Products," to follow immediately after Section 568G thereof, providing for the establishment of the uniform law relating to the production, processing, labeling and distribution of graded milk products in the State of Maryland and providing criminal penalties for violation of said law, AND RELATING TO THE FEES RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBTITLE.
