RENCE WITH REQUESTS FOR SPECIAL CODE PROVISIONS TO MEET LOCAL CONDITIONS WILL NOT BE UNREASONABLY WITHHELD.

(d) (E) The Department of Economic and Community Development shall assume the responsibility to train and certify building code enforcement officials in any jurisdiction where said Model Performance Code is in effect. Moreover, in jurisdictions which have no building code enforcement officials, the Department of Economic and Community Development, through persons it shall find to be qualified, shall provide personnel to effectuate and enforce said Code, and shall establish a schedule of fees and collect the same from applicants for building permits. Said fees shall be set at a level to finance the administration of the program of building code enforcement.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1971.
