

SEC. 2. *AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED*, THAT THIS ACT IS HEREBY DECLARED TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE AND NECESSARY FOR THE IMMEDIATE PRESERVATION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH, AND SAFETY AND HAVING BEEN PASSED BY A YEA AND NAY VOTE SUPPORTED BY THREE-FIFTHS OF ALL THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH OF THE TWO HOUSES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE SAME SHALL TAKE EFFECT FROM THE DATE OF ITS PASSAGE.

CHAPTER 668

(Senate Bill 644)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 36, 57 (b), 57 (e) and 61 (e) SECTION 36 of Article 77A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1970 Supplement), title "Higher Education," subtitle "Scholarships," amending the laws concerning the award of certain scholarships with particular respect to the determination of the financial need of the applicant and of the powers and duties of the State Scholarship Board in relation thereto. TO CHANGE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR DETERMINING THE FINANCIAL NEED OF APPLICANTS FOR AWARD OF SENATORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 36, 57 (b), 57 (e) and 61 (e) SECTION 36 of Article 77A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1970 Supplement), title "Higher Education," subtitle "Scholarships," be and they are IT IS hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and all to read as follows:

Any award to be made according to the provisions of this subtitle shall be given only to an applicant who has met the following conditions: (1) That he shall have passed, in the academic year preceding that for which the award is to be made, a competitive examination to be administered by the State Scholarship Board in accordance with rules and regulations adopted and promulgated by that Board, the pertinent results of which shall be transmitted to the respective appointing authorities, except that when an award is made to a student who is already enrolled in an institution of higher learning and has completed one year of study in good academic standing, the requirement for an examination is waived, (2) that he shall have been, at the time of the examination, a resident of the State and of the senatorial district or subdistrict of the State from which he seeks appointment, except as otherwise provided elsewhere in this article, (3) that he shall have been accepted for admission to the regular undergraduate program of the institution at which the award is to be used and (4) that he shall have accepted any other conditions attached to the granting of the award by the law or by regulations adopted pursuant thereto. The respective appointing authorities, in
