This bill clarifies the law relating to the filing of certain reports or statements with the State Administrative Board of Election Laws by the treasurers of central committees and political committees.

Senate Bill 509, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 6, 1971, accomplished the same purpose as House Bill 6. Moreover, Senate Bill 509 is a more comprehensive bill. Consequently, it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 6.
