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elected official or law enforcement personnel, to be purchased with funds appropriated by this Act, shall comply with the standard specification as devised by the Department of Budget and Fiscal Planning; provided, however, that in the case of the administrative head of any State department or agency whose duties require that 8 he travel extensively throughout the State, the Board of Public Works may authorize the purchase of a class of passenger vehicle 9 10 which is in excess of the standard specification.

SEC. 5. And be it further enacted. That it is the intention that the appropriations contained in this bill for the State Office Buildings in Annapolis and Baltimore are to be supplemented by transfers from the budgets of the various agencies and departments occupying the buildings for such expenses as may not be adequately provided for within the respective budgets for the operation and maintenance of these buildings. The above transfers, if necessary, are to be effected by the budget amendment.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THE EXECUTIVE SHALL CONDUCT A STUDY AND SUBMIT REC OMMENDATIONS TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS WITH RESPECT TO THE SALARIES OF THE SECRETARIES AND DEPUTY SECRETARIES OF THE VARIOUS PRINCIPAL DE-PARTMENTS OF THE STATE COVERNMENT; AND THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, AFTER RECEIVING SUCH RECOMMENDATIONS SHALL ESTABLISH THE SALARIES OF SAID SECRETARIES CONSISTENT WITH THE RESPON-SIBILITIES OF EACH INCUMBENT. THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THESE SALARIES SHALL BE SET FORTH AS AN IDENTIFIABLE PROGRAM OF THE EXECUTIVE DEPART MENT WITH FUNDS PROVIDED AS REIMBURSABLE ITEMS FROM APPROPRIATIONS IN EACH OF THE RESPECTIVE PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENTS.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THE GOVERNOR MAY ALTER THE SALARIES OF THE SEVERAL SECRETARIES AND DEPUTY SECRETARIES OF THE VAR-IOUS PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE STATE GOVERN-MENT ONLY AFTER CAUSING A STUDY TO BE CONDUCTED AS TO THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF EACH POSITION, AFTER SUBMITTING RECOMMENDATIONS BASED ON THE STUDY TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, AND AFTER RECEIV-ING APPROVAL OF THAT BOARD. NOTHING IN THIS SEC-TION SHALL EXTEND OR DIMINISH THE POWER OR AUTHORITY OF THE GOVERNOR OR THE BOARD OVER THE SALARIES OF PERSONNEL OTHER THAN THE SECRETARIES AND DEPUTY SECRETARIES. THE SALARIES OF SECRETARIES AND DEPUTY SECRETARIES SHALL BE SET FORTH INDIVIDUALLY IN MEMORANDUM FORM IN THE BUDGET OF THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT, WITH A 14 THE BUDGET OF THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT, WITH A TOTAL, AS WELL AS IN THE BUDGETS OF THE RESPECTIVE PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENTS AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO SUBSEQUENT APPROVAL OR DISAPPROVAL BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND IF DISAPPROVED, THE SALARY OR SALARIES SHALL REVERT TO THE AMOUNT OR AMOUNTS PRIOR TO SUCH INCREASE OR INCREASES ESTABLISHED 21 UNDER THIS SECTION. 23
