Upon motion of Mr. Hodgson, duly seconded by Mr. Tolson, and passed by a unanimous vote, it was resolved that the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

A Resolution to repeal subsection (g) of Section 103-B of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition) entitled, "Queen Anne's County," subtitle "Town of Centreville," as enacted by Chapter 638 of the Acts of 1953 and amendments thereto, and to enact in lieu thereof, a new subsection (g) of Section 103-B to stand in place and stead of the subsection so repealed and to relate to, and extend the time limit over which the Commissioners may determine special assessments to be due from ten to forty years.
