AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That as soon as the Charter Amendment hereby made shall become effective, either as herein provided or following a Referendum, the Mayor shall send separately, by registered mail, to the Secretary of the State of Maryland, and to the Department of Legislative Reference of Maryland, a complete certified copy of the text of this Resolution, the date of the Referendum, if any is held, a certificate showing the number of Councilmen voting for and against it, and a Report on the votes cast for or against the amendment hereby enacted at any Referendum thereon, and the effective date of the Charter Amendment.
