vided further that a fair summary of the proposed amendments shall be published in the Cumberland Evening Times, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Cumberland, once in each of the weeks of July 6, 13, 20, and 27, 1970.

Section 4. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor of the City of Cumberland is hereby specifically directed to carry out the provisions of Section 3 hereof, regarding the giving of notice by posting and publication of this Resolution approving the same, and, as evidence of said compliance, the City Clerk shall cause to be affixed hereto a certificate of publication of the newspaper in which the summary of this Resolution shall have been published, and the Mayor, if there is no Petition for a Referendum, shall declare the Charter Amendment made to be effective on the effective date herein provided for, which is August 25, 1970, by affixing his signature hereto in the space provided below the effective date hereof.

Section 5. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That as soon as the Charter amendments hereby made shall become effective, either as herein provided or following a Referendum, the Mayor shall send separately, by registered mail, to the Secretary of the State of Maryland, and to the Department of Legislative Reference of Maryland, a complete certified copy of the text of this Resolution, the date of the Referendum, if any is held, and a certificate showing the number of Councilmen voting for and against it, and a report on the votes cast for or against the amendments hereby enacted at any Referendum thereon, and the effective date of the Charter Amendment.
