provided or following a Referendum, the Mayor shall send separately, by registered mail, to the Secretary of the State of Maryland, and to the Department of Legislative Reference of Maryland, a complete certified copy of the text of this Resolution, the date of the Referendum, if any is held, and a certificate showing the number of Councilmen voting for and against it, and a report on the votes cast for or against the amendments hereby enacted at any referendum thereon, and the effective date of the Charter Amendment.

Resolution No. 50

RESOLUTION of the Mayor and City Council of Cumberland, Maryland, adopted in pursuance of the authority contained in Article 11-E of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, and Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, entitled "Municipal Corporations," as said Section was enacted by Chapter 423 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1955, entitled "A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF CUMBERLAND, MARYLAND (1966 EDITION), BY REPEALING AND REENACTING, WITH AMENDMENTS, SECTION 28 OF SAID CHARTER, FOUND UNDER THE SUBTITLE 'MAYOR AND COUNCIL', AND DEALING WITH THE DUTIES, ETC., OF THE COMMISSIONER OF FINANCE."

Section 1.
