NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Mayor and Council of Easton that enlargement of the corporate boundaries of the Town of Easton be and it is hereby proposed that by annexation of the area comprised within the boundaries described below, the Town boundaries shall be changed in accordance with the following description, which is attached hereto; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a public hearing be held by this body with respect to said proposed annexation, such hearing to be held in the office of the Mayor and Council of Easton, at 8:00 o'clock P.M. on Monday, October 19, 1970; provided that public notice of such hearing shall first be given pursuant to the provisions of Section 19(d) of said Article 23A; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event this Resolution shall be finally enacted following said Public Hearing, then this Resolution and the annexation hereby proposed shall become effective forty-five (45) days following such final enactment.
