Resolution

Resolved by the Council of the Town of Manchester, that the Municipal Corporation Charter be amended in the following manner; i.e., Section 21(b) be amended to read as follows:

(b) Appointments and removal of employees and heads of offices, departments and agencies.

The Mayor, with the approval of the Council shall appoint the heads of all offices, departments and agencies of the town government as established by this Charter or by Ordinance, as well as all other employees of the town. All such heads of offices, departments and agencies and all other employees of the town shall be removed or terminated by the Mayor, acting with consent of the Council. Any such person so removed or terminated shall be entitled to a hearing on said removal or dismissal before the Mayor and Council, provided such a hearing is requested in writing not later than 15 days after the notice of removal or dismissal.
