enactment shall be and become effective on November 24, 1970, unless a proper petition for a referendum hereon shall be filed as permitted by law. A complete and exact copy of this Resolution shall be posted in the City Hall until November 14, 1970, and a copy of the Title of this Resolution shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Rockville not less than four (4) times, at weekly intervals, before November 14, 1970.

Section 3. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as soon as the charter amendment hereby enacted shall become effective, either as herein provided or following a referendum, the Mayor of The Mayor and Council of Rockville shall send separately, by registered mail, to the Secretary of State of Maryland, and to the Department of Legislative Reference, the following information concerning the charter amendment: (1) the complete text of new subsection (e) of Section 48-4 of the Charter of The Mayor and Council of Rockville, as hereby enacted; (2) the date of the referendum election, if any, held with respect thereto; (3) the number of votes cast for and against the question containing the charter amendment, whether by the Council of The Mayor and Council of Rockville or in a referendum; and (4) the effective date of the charter amendment.

Section 4. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of The Mayor and Council of Rockville be and he is hereby specifically enjoined and instructed to carry out the provisions of Sections 2 and 3. As evidence of compliance herewith, the said Mayor shall cause to be affixed to the minutes of this meeting (1) appropriate certificates of publication of the newspaper in which the Title of this Resolution shall have been published and (2) the return receipts of the mailing referred to in Section 3, and shall further complete and execute the Certificate of Effect attached hereto.
