Section 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that new Sections 1-217 (159) and (160) be and they are hereby added to said Code, Title, Subtitle and Article to read as follows:

(159) *Photographer*—Graduation from a recognized high school and five (5) years of experience as a commercial, industrial, news or portrait photographer, and in photographic laboratory work. College education may be substituted for up to, but no more than, two (2) years of required experience.

(160) *GATEKEEPER AND Scale Man*—Graduation from a recognized high school and three (3) years of related work experience, preferably some experience in clerical work; or any equivalent combination of education and experience.

Section 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) days after it becomes law.

AN ORDINANCE to repeal Section 17-203 (a) of the Anne Arundel County Code (1967 Edition and Supplements), Title 17, "Taxation", Subtitle 2, "Assessment and Levy", and to enact new Section 17-203 (a) in lieu thereof, to stand in the place of the section repealed, allowing a tax credit for certain homeowners, and matters generally related thereto.

Section 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 17-203 (a) of the Anne Arundel County Code (1967 Edition and Supplements), Title 17,
